

# Junction City Area Chamber of Commerce Christmas Parade

## General Information For Parade Goers

### **Where to Watch:**

- The parade may be viewed on either side of Washington Street, south to 6th Street. The parade concludes at Heritage Park, with floats turning east on 6th Street. The final float, featuring the Commanding General's Mounted Color Guard, VIP guests, Santa and Mrs. Claus, ends at Heritage Park, where they will disembark at Santa's House.
- Streets will begin being barricaded at approximately 4 pm. Most streets will be manned and closed to traffic by 5 PM. Please arrive early to enjoy local shops and restaurants before the parade and secure a prime viewing spot.

### **What to Expect:**

- Experience festive floats, community spirit, and holiday cheer.
- The parade begins at 5:30 PM. Santa and Mrs. Claus will be available to meet children after the parade in Heritage Park.

### **Parking Information:**

- Free parking is available on Jefferson from 18th to 6th Street.
- Note that the side streets along the parade route (Washington), from Grant Avenue (18th Street) to 6th Street, will be closed during the parade and the JCPD and Geary County Sheriff's Department will be manning those intersections for the safety of everyone. Please plan accordingly to navigate during the parade.
- To ensure the parade is safe and enjoyable for everyone DO NOT PARK along the parade route along either side of Washington street after 3 pm. If parked on Washington Street at the parade's start, you must remain in place until the parade concludes for safety reasons.
